Members learn communication skills by working in the [Competent Communication manual](#), a series of 10 self-paced speaking assignments designed to instill a basic foundation in public speaking.

Members also learn leadership skills by taking on various meeting roles and working in the [Competent Leadership manual](#). In our learn-by-doing approach, we don't lecture members about leadership skills; we give them responsibilities and provide mentorship which builds confidence and leads to improvement.
